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department. There are 14 physiotherapy schools at university level graduating approx. 400 students per year. The physiotherapy qualification leads to an academic degree (Bachelor and Master). The university training goes on for 3 years to an academic degree Bachelor in Physiotherapy (180 ECTS) and 2 years to an Master level (120 ECTS). All schools offer Bachelor degree studying programme, 4 of them offer Master programme. Studies allow for postgraduate education. The education of physiotherapists graduated on the High school level (according the previous educating system) is presently fully respected.
